FRIENDS, Inc. is a nonprofit organization that provides shelter and support services to survivors of Domestic Violence in Washington County. Since 1978, we have provided survivors with trauma-informed, victim-centered services and programming that support individuals and families live a non-violent independent life.

Our Mission: To empower those affected by Domestic Violence by offering safety, support, and community awareness.

FRIENDS, Inc., originally named "Friends for Battered Women," and then "Friends of Abused Families," was established and began programming in 1978 with three volunteers who answered a 24-hour crisis line and provided short-term shelter for women and children that were in immediate crisis.


Today, FRIENDS, Inc.'s team provides:

 24/7 Crisis Line: Staff are available 24/7 over the phone to help individuals identify the signs of Domestic Violence, develop a safety plan, and identify next steps for crisis resolution.

- Emergency Shelter: We provide Shelter and support to individuals and families who are fleeing from abusive households or relationships.
- Individual Advocacy: Individuals can meet lv1 with our Advocates to receive support and empowerment to reach their goals.

Presentation topics address the different types of violence and harassment, healthy and unhealthy relationships, respect, technology safety, protective behaviors, and bullying.

All of FRIENDS, Inc.'s services are free and confidential. Support is available to ALL individuals regardless of gender, race, citizenship, disability, income, religion, or age so EVERYONE can get the support they deserve.

FRIENDS, Inc. recognizes the prevalence of Domestic Violence in our community and the extreme need to continue providing these services. Our agency and mission is dependent on our community coming together and working to put an end to violence.
